

- A structured college preparatory system working directly with schools and districts
- An academic support system
- A <u>school wide</u> approach to curriculum and rigor
- A structured college preparatory elective class that helps students with organizational skills, note taking, and WICOR strategies.
 - W-Writing
 - I -Inquiry
 - C-Collaboration
 - O-Organization
 - o R-Rigor
- Tutorology: Small group tutoring

Edison AVID Senior Data

Last year's AVID seniors (Class of 2018)

- 100% completed four-year college entrance requirements
- 76% took a course of rigor (AP/honors)
- Average GPA 3.0

- 100% applied to four-year colleges
- 97% were *accepted* into four-year colleges
- 97% EHS AVID *enrolled* in college

Expectations of an AVID Student

- Maintain an AVID binder.
- Maintain satisfactory citizenship and attendance in all classes.
- Participate in team building activities.
- Explore college options.
- Gain awareness of professional careers.
- Interact with guest speakers.
- Interact with and learn from college tutors.
- Tour college campuses and visit with college admission.
- Participate in extra-curricular and community service activities. (10 hours a year **required** once in high school)
- Enroll in one or more advanced academic courses.
- Commit to working hard and studying every night to maintain a 2.5 or higher GPA.
